What is the Hodogaya Multicultural Community Plan?

- Aim : Hodogaya Ward has over 5,500 foreign residents from over 80 countries and regions. As an extension of Hodogaya Ward's main goal to create a community that people want to call home, this plan aims to create a community where this is true for all residents, regardless of their nationality.
- Plan Period Four year period between April 2022 and March 2026.

Hodogaya's Foreign Population by the Numbers

★ Increasing foreign population


- Of Yokohama's 18 wards, Hodogaya has the 6th largest foreign population.
- Hodogaya's foreign population has increased four-fold in the past 30 years.
- As of March 2020, Hodogaya's foreign population was 5,862 (5,509 as of March 2021, due to the influence of COVID-19)


■ Trends in Hodogaya's foreign population (People)
